 - Operational walkthrough and end-to-end review, including identification of process improvements and ROI

- The CoE is primarily used early phases, but by the time that they get halfway through the project, the project team is running on their own and the CoE is just checking in occasionally to make sure that things are proceeding as planned, and to help resolve any issues. They had to make some organizational changes to ensure that the CoE is engaged at the right time and that siloed solutions are avoided.
